Maths

We have come to the end of our place value topic. (Year 4s are up to tens of thousands.)


This topic includes partitioning numbers (e.g. with a part-whole model to show place values), representing numbers and estimating on a number line, flexible partitioning (i.e. finding multiple ways to partition numbers), ordering numbers and counting in steps of 50. Additionally, Year 4 have visited Roman Numerals and rounding numbers. Our activities have frequently been arranged around paired games with dice and 0-9 digit cards to develop our social skills and have fun.

We will be moving on shortly to addition and subtraction, which will be our next topic.

English

Within our English sessions, continuing with our inspirational Explorers, we have been composing Diary entries based on real life adventurers. How exciting! We've been imagining how it would feel to discover new territories and experience different encounters. We are learning how to highlight key features of the text and extract information which we can use for our own creative writing.
