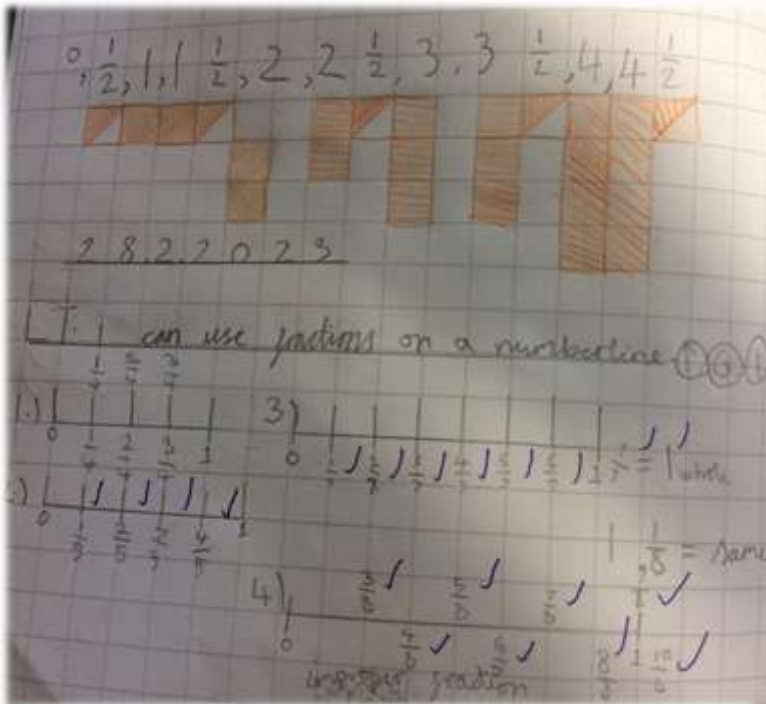


# What we have been up to in Wells Class recently...

## Maths

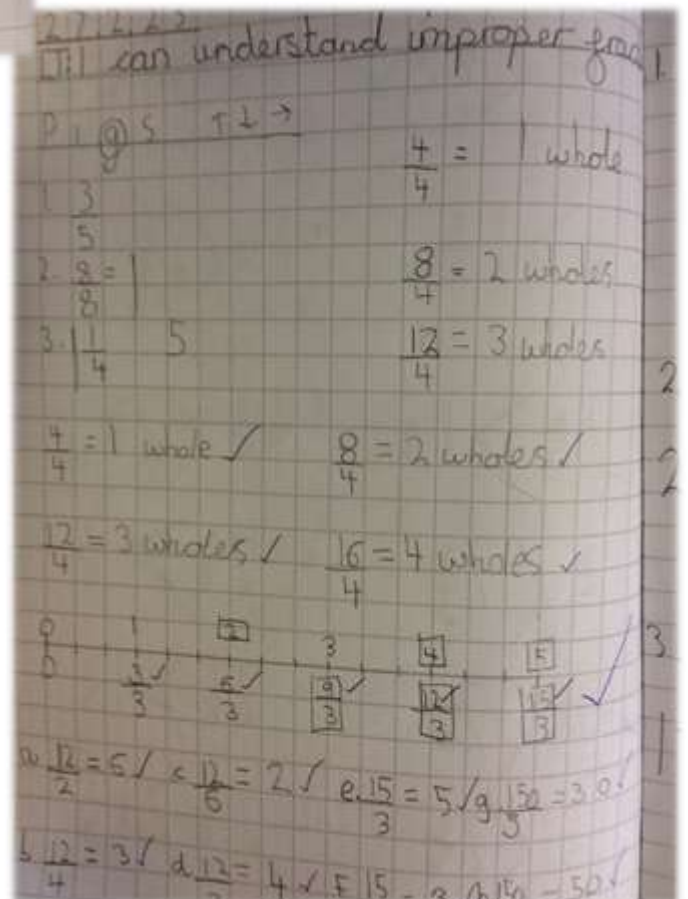
Fantastic Fractions have been our current focus in maths.



Year 3s have been looking at a mix of unit, non-unit fractions. Working out where they sit on a number line and what fractions are equivalent.

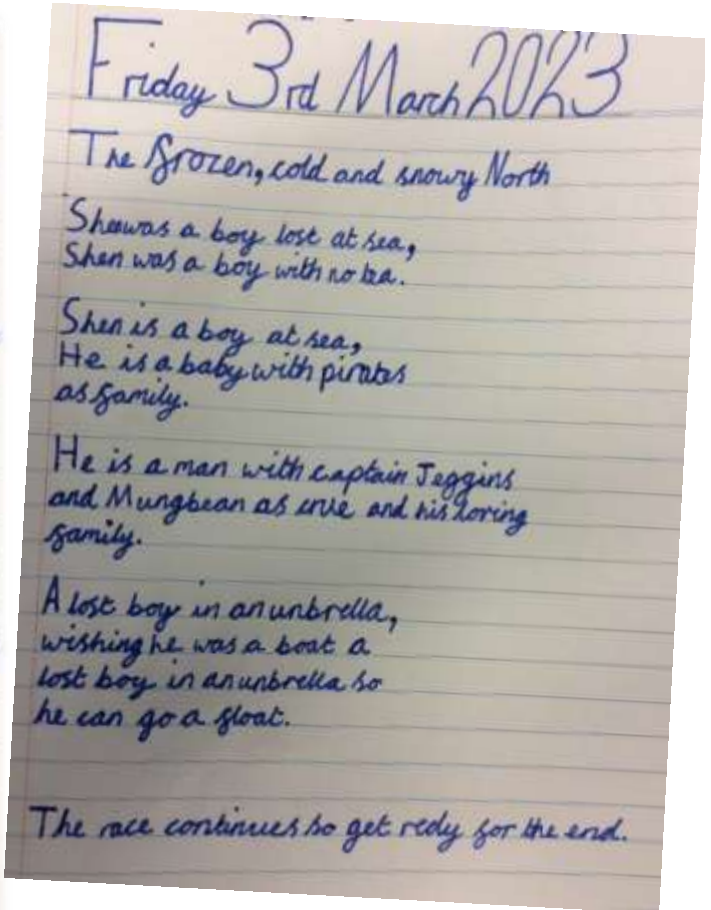
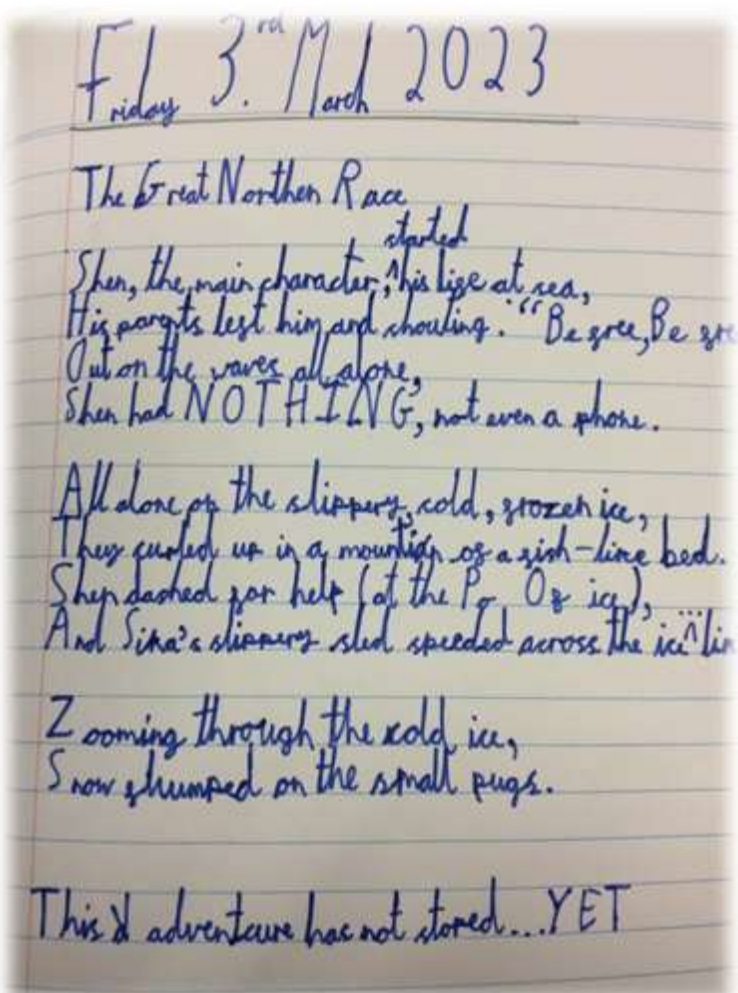
In Year 4, we have been learning how to convert mixed numbers into improper fractions

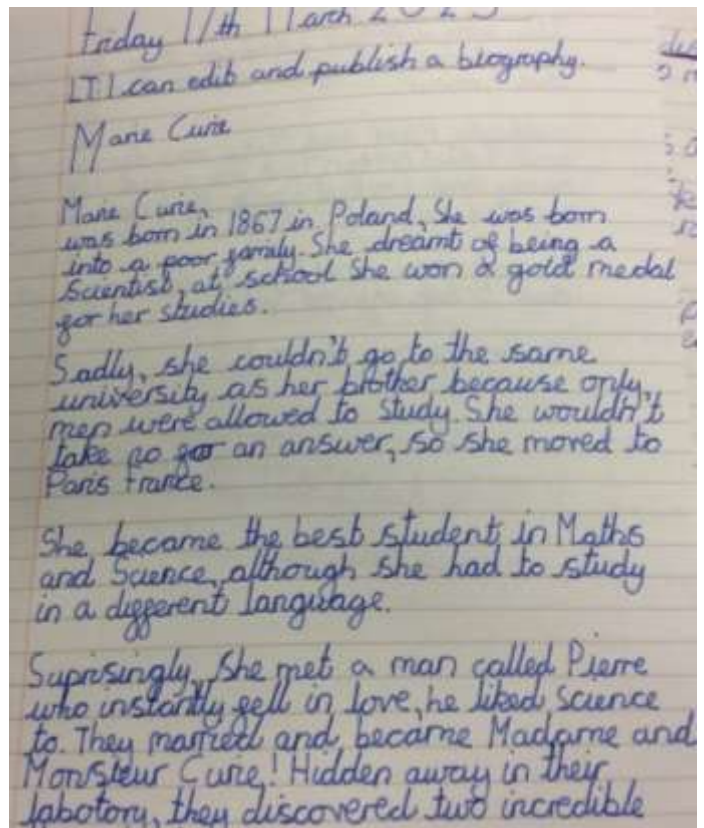
We are looking forwards to our Poet in residence, **Simon Mole** coming into visit us soon...
